PARTICIPATION IN INDIVIDUAL QUALIFICATION

The age of the **MAG gymnasts** in 2019 was 16 or 17 years old (born 2002 or 2003).

57 National Federations (NF) participated.




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








5. MEDAL DISTRIBUTION BY CONTINENTS





Total of 13 gymnasts won medals in the All around & Apparatus finals






Comparison of highest/lowest final score in Qualification

Comparison of highest/lowest E score in Qualification












Double salto performed during qualification




Double salto performed during FLOOR final

2 times during qualifications.



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





5 gymnasts performed Russian wendeswing as a dismount and as a separate skill.
































Dismount:

14. JUDGING ACTIVITIES

46 NF were represented by 54 judges. Two reserve judges were invited.

24 NF were represented by 12 R and 12 D judges.

The D and R judges' selection was conducted in Györ from the pool of judges from category 1 and 2, nominated by the participating National Federations.

E judges draw took place before each phase of the competition.

Two judges had to be replaced with reserves due to judges concerned not attending the instruction.

All judges category 1, 2 and 3, received at least 1 E position.

Judges briefing

Judges received all relevant information from Members of the Technical Committee. The instructions and practice were for the both D and E judges' panels.

Podium training

Podium Training for the competition was conducted in accordance with the Qualification schedule. Absolute majority of the judges stayed for all subdivisions in the venue.

The D panels evaluated all of the routines that were shown by the gymnasts during the podium training. All controversial elements were immediately reported to the coaches.

Competition

The D- Panels were very consistent and used the same criteria to evaluate the performances of all the gymnasts.

The E judges work is to be commended. Intervention of R judges score in all phases of the competition is shown in the table below:
